BYLAW 40/2018

RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BYLAW AMENDMENT

Being Amendment 1 to the Residential Solid Waste Management Bylaw17/2018

The Council of the City of St. Albert, duly assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Bylaw 17/2018, Residential Solid Waste Management Bylaw, is hereby amended by this Bylaw.
2. Section 2 is amended as follows:
 - a. Subsection 2(z) is deleted and replaced with the following:

“2(z) “Organics” means leaves, grass clippings, weeds, garden waste, house and garden plants, shrubbery and tree prunings, sawdust, wood shavings, soiled paper products, shredded paper, paper towel, tissues, tissue paper, kitchen food waste (fruits, vegetables and peelings, table scraps, meat, poultry, fish, shell fish, dairy products, cooking oil, grease, fat, bread, grain, rice, pasta, bones, egg shells, coffee grounds and filters, tea leaves and bags) and any other substance or material as the City Manager from time to time deems an “organic”;
 - b. Subsection 2(dd) is deleted and replaced with the following:

“2(dd) “Recyclable” means mixed paper, corrugated cardboard, boxboard, newsprint, magazines, catalogues, flyers, telephone or other soft cover books, rigid plastic food and household bottles, lids and containers, plastic milk jugs or waxed cardboard milk containers, books with covers removed, aluminum, steel and tin cans or other similar material as the City Manager from time to time deems suitable for Collection Services;”
3. Section 33(j)(i) is amended by revising the wording “empty and rinsed colostomy bags;” to “empty and/or sealed colostomy bags;”
4. Section 33(j)(ii) is amended by revising the wording “empty and rinsed gastric and nasal tubes;” to “empty and/or sealed gastric and nasal tubes;”

5. The Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to consolidate Bylaw 17/2018.
