Business Support Grants	Grant program		Offers 7 streams of grant programs aimed at advancing economic growth, improving city vibrancy, and helping businesses thrive in the areas of: Business Improvement Areas, Brownfield development, corner stores, Chinatown vibrancy, graffiti, community murals, and building energy retrofits.

Downtown Calgary Development Incentive Program	Financial reimbursement program		The program is intended to increase overall economic activity, vibrancy and safety; accelerate the delivery of housing; and ensure good quality development in the Greater Downtown Plan Area. Ranges from \$50 to \$75/square for eligible uses, including multi-residential, hotel, schools, etc.
Targeted Redevelopment Incentive Program	Property tax rebate	City of Lethbridge	Offers a tax rebate for targeted redevelopment projects in our urban core districts that have a budget of at least \$500,000. Offers \$300,000 to \$4,000,000 per project.

Non-residential Development Incentive Program	Property tax exemption	Drumheller	Aimed at new business developments and/or business expansions may be eligible for property tax exemptions. Two-year tax exemption up to a maximum of \$3,000.
Economic Development Incentive	Property tax exemption	Chestermere	Offers 1-3 years of tax exemption on new commercial and industrial construction.
