### 2026 Project Plan Funding Requests

J. Blackwood led a discussion in regard to funding allocation to support upcoming public art projects. The committee asked questions, provided input and feedback.

Administration has worked collaboratively with internal stakeholders and the Arts Development Advisory Committee to identify three opportunities for the inclusion of Public Art in one Capital Project currently in development, and two opportunities for space enhancement with the addition of Public Art. The following projects Administration is seeking funding towards are:

1. Midtown Park & Connector Park  
Funding allocation: \$200,000
2. The Recycle Yard Sea Can Mural  
Funding allocation: \$35,000
3. Secret Park Public Art site activation  
Funding allocation: \$15,000
