## **Purpose**

The *Municipal Government Act* and the *Procedure Bylaw* allow Councillors to attend a meeting of Council by <u>electronic</u> means<u>of electronic communications</u>. This policy specifies the circumstances under which this option is available to Councillors.

## **Policy Statement**

Councillors may attend a Ceouncil meetings by means of electronic communications.

### **Definitions**

"Council" means the municipal Council of the City of St. Albert;

"Councillor" means a member of Council and includes the mayor; and

"meeting" means any gathering of a quorum of Councillors where they provide direction on any matter of which Council has authority at that gathering, including Committee of the Whole, and Council meetings;

#### Responsibilities

The Chief Administrative Officer shall, where possible, provide a location for Council meetings where Councillors may participate by electronic means.

#### Service Standards/ Expectations

 Councillors shall make every effort to attend Council meetings in person and only attend Council meetings via electronic means due to unforeseen, extenuating, or extraordinary circumstances.



- 4.2. A Councillor Councillors shall only be permitted to attend a meeting by electronic means of electronic communications if the location in which the meeting is to be held is equipped in a manner such that enables all Councillors and members of the public participating in the meeting to hear the meeting as it occurs and make submissions, as appropriate, during the course of the meeting watch or hear one another.
- 2.3. A Councillor attending a meeting by electronic communications means is deemed to be present at the meeting for whatever period of time that the connection via electronic communications means remains active.
- 3.4. The mMayor shall announce to all in attendance at the meeting that the if a Councillor is attending the meeting by electronic means of electronic communications.
- 4.5. When a vote is called, Councillors attending by <u>electronic</u> means of <u>electronic communications</u> shall be asked to state their vote only after all <u>Councillors present in the meeting room have cast their votes</u>, either via electronic voting system or by show of hands.
- 5.6. Other than for the purpose of attending a Ceouncil meeting, Councillors shall not communicate with each other electronically during a Council meeting by means such as e-mail, instant messaging, or social networking websites.
