Council Remuneration Review Committee Bylaw

Records Bylaw

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 208(1)(d) of the *Municipal Government Act* the Chief Administrative Officer must ensure that all City Records and documents are kept safe;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 214 of the *Municipal Government Act*, S.A. 2000, c. M26 Council may pass a Bylaw respecting the destruction of Records and documents of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS, the provisions of applicable access to information and protection of privacy legislation ~~Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act~~ does not prohibit the transfer, storage or destruction of any Record in accordance with a Bylaw of a local government body;
