7. The CAO is the Head of the City for the purposes of the <u>Access to Information Act</u>, <u>SA 2024</u>, <u>c A-1.4</u> and <u>Protection of Privacy Act</u>, <u>SA 2024</u>, <u>c P-28.5</u> Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, R.S.A. 2000 c. F-25.

# **Council Remuneration Review Committee Bylaw**

16. The Committee may hold its meetings and conduct or discuss its research in camera where permitted by the provisions of the *Municipal Government Act* and the <u>Access to Information ActFreedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act</u>.

### **Electronic Transmission of Assessment and Taxation Communication Bylaw**

2. In this bylaw:

h. "FOIP Act" means the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act*, RSA 2000, c F-25;

18. Any information collected from a Taxpayer or Assessed Person shall be protected in accordance with the provisions of the *Protection of Privacy Act*, SA 2024, c P-28.5, as amended FOIP Act.

# Records Bylaw

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 208(1)(d) of the Municipal Government Act the Chief Administrative Officer must ensure that all City Records and documents are kept safe;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 214 of the *Municipal Government Act*, S.A. 2000, c. M26 Council may pass a Bylaw respecting the destruction of Records and documents of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS, the <u>provisions of applicable access to information and protection of privacy legislation</u> <u>Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act</u> does not prohibit the transfer, storage or destruction of any Record in accordance with a Bylaw of a local government body;

3. In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:

a) "Act" means the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, S.A. 200, c. F-25;
