BUDGET INFORMATION REQUEST (BIR) - Broadcasting of Council & Committee Meetings

QUESTION

Please provide a low, medium and high scope option to upgrade the Douglas Cardinal Boardroom and/or the Council Chambers to improve the broadcasting of council and SCOW meetings, and the benefits and limitations of each option.

RESPONSE

Several technology options that deliver the functions needed for both the Douglas Cardinal Boardroom (DCB) and Council Chambers (Chambers) have been reviewed to determine the most appropriate one to be used as the basis for this BIR. This does not in any way presume the selection of this technology but, rather, it is used solely as the basis for cost estimates in this BIR.

These technology options support automation for both locations. For all levels of estimates (low, medium and high), they provide a robust and consolidated platform with centralized control for both rooms. Since there is a base level needed to achieve these outcomes, the terms “good”, “better” and “best” have been used instead of “low”, “medium” and “high”.

Best efforts will be used to reuse existing technology in Chambers which would reduce costs. Since it is uncertain how much technology can be reused, no reductions are included in these estimates. As well, actual costs will vary from vendor to vendor and will be confirmed through an RFP process. From the budgetary estimates collected for this BIR, the higher costs were used in the tables below as there are a number of unknowns at this time.

Administration would be able to use this technology for all types of meetings, in addition to Council meetings and Committee meetings. For the purposes of this BIR, the categories of low, medium and high scope options are translated to good, better, best respectfully.

By its nature, this type of technology is highly visual and complex with tight integration of different hardware and software components provided by multiple vendors. Although every effort has been taken to remove this complexity from this BIR, follow-up information and/or product demonstrations may be required to gain a complete understanding.

Good, Better, Best Options

All three options for Chambers include the same basic hardware and system configuration with the differences being the type of discussion station and the type of meeting management software.

For DCB, the options include a wireless system with only one type of discussion station. As such, the difference between the two options is the choice of meeting management software used with the discussion stations.

As mentioned, this type of technology is particularly complex with many options available. The table below provides a basic summary of the differences between the options. All discussion stations in options for both Chambers and DCB have multiple choices for microphones.

Good

This option includes standard discussion stations for Council, Administration and participants. Although these stations use touch screens, the functions are limited to “request to speak” and “mute”.

These standard stations provide the following capabilities:

- vote and see vote results
- display current speaker
- speech time progress bar showing elapsed speaking time
- view speaker list showing current and upcoming speakers based on “request to speak”
- view next agenda item (no update capability)

Standard meeting management includes the following functions:

- create and publish meetings with an assigned room, a list of participants, an agenda, voting items and seat assignment.
- create and manage an organization and a delegates database.
- create meeting templates for quick reuse
- automatic camera control

There is no legislative software integration with this option.

Better

This option provides touch screen discussion stations for Mayor and Councilors and standard discussion stations for Administration and participants.

The touch screen discussion stations provide the following capabilities:

- view any video output in the meeting including all cameras and the video stream to YouTube displayed as the entire screen or as small screen in screen windows
- view presentations on the touch screen and zoom-in if needed
- view and update entire agenda items highlighting current agenda item is integrated with the City’s meeting management software
- view speaker list showing current and upcoming speakers based on “request to speak”
- built-in camera for the active speaker
- built-in speakers with automatic mute function when microphone is live
- speech time progress bar showing elapsed speaking time
- voting and result visualization
- ability to mute microphones and control audio in the room

Meeting management functions are the same as the “Good” option above.

There is no legislative software integration with this option.

Best

This option also provides touch screen discussion stations for the Mayor and Councilors and standard

discussion stations for Administration and participants.

Enhanced meeting management includes the following functions:

- control all aspects of the meeting such as voting sessions and microphones
- conference systems control and web browsing
- user interfaces and hall-displays can be tailored to Council's needs
- optimized for live meetings: change or add agenda items and voting sessions, re-assign delegates to seats, and change voting rights when delegates leave the meeting.
- full remote participant support including microphone control and voting integration
- full paperless integration: all reports are stored as PDF.
- exports to local government meeting management systems are supported
- manual or fully automatic camera control
- participants, voting results, agendas, and presentations can automatically be displayed in multi-split-screen or picture-in-picture.
- additional information such as speaking time and name is automatically added to each speaker
- integration with legislative meeting management systems is available. (note: the City's current vendor has been contacted for integration and at this time, based on available information, is not responsive. Other meeting management vendors are currently ready to integrate.)
- bring your own device support included

The wireless system for the DCB offers a more basic discussion station that will be available soon. It has not been included in the Good/Best options as the availability date is currently unknown.

Good

This option provides wireless standard discussion stations for Council and Administration.

These touch screens provide the following capabilities:

- view any video output in the meeting including all cameras and the video stream to YouTube displayed as the entire screen or as small screen in screen windows.
- view presentations on the touch screen and zoom in if needed.
- view and update entire agenda items highlighting current agenda item, integrated with the City's meeting management software
- view speaker list showing current and upcoming speakers based on "request to speak."
- built-in camera for the active speaker
- built-in speakers with automatic mute function when microphone is live
- speech time progress bar showing elapsed speaking time
- voting and result visualization
- ability to mute microphones and control audio in the room.

Standard meeting management includes the following functions:

- create and publish meetings with an assigned room, a list of participants, an agenda, voting items and seat assignment.
- create and manage an organization and a delegates database.
- create meeting templates for quick reuse.
- Automatic camera control

There is no legislative software integration with this option.

Best

The wireless discussion stations in the "Good" option are included in the "Best" option.

Enhanced meeting management includes the following functions:

- voting license
- "badge identification" (who is listed in the queue to speak)
- control all aspects of the conference system like starting voting sessions, control microphones and ID card programming
- full remote participant support including microphone control and voting integration
- conference systems control and web browsing.
- user interfaces and hall-displays can be tailored to Council's needs
- easy meeting preparation for your conference system, by Excel and support for connectivity to local government systems.
- optimized for live meetings: change or add agenda items and voting sessions, re-assign delegates to seats, perform live card programming and change voting rights when delegates leave the meeting.
- full paperless integration: All reports are stored as PDF
- exports to local government meeting management systems are supported
- manual or fully automatic camera control
- participants, voting results, agendas, and presentations can automatically be displayed in multi-split-

screen or picture-in-picture.

- additional information such as speaking time and name is automatically added to each speaker
- integration with legislative meeting management systems is available. Note: the City's current vendor has been contacted for integration and at this time, based on available information, is not responsive. Other meeting management vendors are currently ready to integrate.

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
