Edmonton	Community Investment Operating Grant	Grants ranged from \$400 to \$16,500 in 2018. Max grant per organization is up to \$20,000.	Can NOT receive operating funding from any other City of Edmonton grant or funding directly from Council in order to be eligible. Organization operating expenses must be under \$2 million to be eligible and grant can not exceed 25% of total operating budget. In 2018, 292 groups were funded. Total budget envelope is approx. \$3.7 per capita.
Fort Saskatchewan	Not offered		Grant only available for specific projects, programs or initiatives.
Grande Prairie	Community Operating Grants	Grant Budget currently at \$3.6 million but this includes the Library, the Regional Library contribution (Peace Library Systems), Art Gallery, as well as additional Outside Agencies.	Grant amounts vary greatly from \$10,000 to \$1.7 million (Main Library). Program is currently under review with changes expected to be proposed by summer 2020. Municipal contact was not specific to funding allocated to Outside Agencies only as varies each year.
