UTILITY RATES AND FEES AMENDMENT

Being Amendment 29 to the Water Bylaw 5/2001
Being Amendment 2 to the Residential Solid Waste Management Bylaw 6/2025
Being Amendment 10 to the Sanitary Sewer Bylaw 6/2018
Being Amendment 23 to the Storm Sewer Bylaw 6/2003

WHEREAS the Council of the City of St. Albert has considered adjustments to various utility rates, fees, and charges set by bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of St. Albert hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Bylaws 5/2001, 6/2025, 6/2018, and 6/2003 are amended by this Bylaw.
- 2. Schedule "A" of Bylaw 5/2001 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with Schedule "A" of this Bylaw entitled "Water Bylaw Schedule A".
- 3. Bylaw 6/2025 is amended by adding a new heading entitled "Billing Errors" immediately after section 36 and a new section 36.1 as follows:
 - 36.1 (a) If the City issues a utility bill that contains an error from the fees from Schedule "A" of the Residential Solid Waste Bylaw charged, the City may issue a supplementary utility bill that corrects the error and:
 - (i) charges the Customer any additional amount owing if the error understated the charge; and
 - (ii) refunds to the customer any amount which the Customer has overpaid if the error overstated the charge.
 - (b) In the case of an overpayment by the Customer, the CAO may instead of refunding an amount to the Customer set it off against a future utility bill.
- 4. Schedule "A" of Bylaw 6/2025 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with Schedule "A" of this Bylaw entitled "Residential Solid Waste Management Bylaw Schedule A".



- 5. Schedule "C" of Bylaw 6/2018 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with Schedule "C" of this Bylaw entitled "Sanitary Sewer Bylaw Schedule C".
- 6. Bylaw 6/2003 is amended by adding a new heading entitled "Billing Errors" immediately after section 19 and a new section 19.1 as follows:
 - 19.1 (1) If the City issues a utility bill that contains an error in calculation of the storm sewer fees charged, the City may issue a supplementary utility bill that corrects the error and:
 - (a) charges the Customer any additional amount owing if the error understated the storm sewer charge; and
 - (b) refunds to the customer any amount which the Customer has overpaid if the error overstated the storm sewer charge.
 - (2) In the case of an overpayment by the Customer, the Director may instead of refunding an amount to the Customer set it off against a future utility bill.
- 7. Schedule "A" of Bylaw 6/2003 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with Schedule "A" of this Bylaw entitled "Storm Sewer Bylaw Schedule A".
- 8. The Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to issue a consolidated version of Bylaws 5/2001, 6/2025, 6/2018, and 6/2003 that incorporates the amendments made by this amending bylaw and otherwise conforms with the requirements of section 69 of the *Municipal Government Act*.
