TITLE: ENHANCED ELECTION MANAGEMENT FUNDING

On February 19, 2017, Councillor Heron provided notice in accordance with Section 23 of Procedure Bylaw 35/2009 that he/she intended to bring forward the proposed motion below.

In order for Council to debate the motion, the motion must be formally moved.

“That the operating business case from CSS- Legislative Services Enhanced Election Management Capacity for \$30,000 be funded from the 2016 operating surplus.”

BACKGROUND:

During the 2017 budget process, Council approved the Operating Business Case titled “Enhanced Election Management Capacity” for a one-time cost of \$30,000.

As per C-FS-05 Budget Guiding principles, this business case was funded through new assessment growth. Funding of this business case through the 2016 surplus, as contemplated in this motion, will increase the amount of the unallocated new assessment growth, which by policy will be transferred to the Growth Stabilization reserve for use in a future year.

Administration has no issues with this motion.
