

## Solitary Beekeeping Regulations

1. Solitary Bee houses on a parcel of land that has an area less than 929 m<sup>2</sup> (10,000 ft<sup>2</sup>):
  - a. A maximum of one (1) large bee house not measuring more than 6,452 cm<sup>2</sup> (1,000 in<sup>2</sup>) in size on one (1) parcel of land; or
  - b. A maximum of five (5) bee houses each individually not measuring more than 625 cm<sup>2</sup> (97 in<sup>2</sup>) in size on one (1) parcel of land.
2. Solitary Bee houses on a parcel of land equal to or greater than 929 m<sup>2</sup> (10,000 ft<sup>2</sup>), the number of bee houses or size of the solitary bee houses are not specified.
3. The placement of solitary bee houses on City owned and operated land requires permission by Public Works.
