## Being Amendment 1 to the St. Albert Youth Council Bylaw 26/2016

- 4. Section 19(i) the word "Council" after the wording "issues of significance to the Youth" be deleted and replaced with "Advisory Committee".
- 5. The current Schedule "A", which forms part of this bylaw, be removed and replaced with a new Schedule "A" attached herein.
- 6. The Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to consolidate Bylaw 26/2016.
- 7. This bylaw shall come into force and effect when it receives third reading and is duly signed.

## Schedule A – Code of Conduct

- 1. Committee Members must conduct themselves in a positive, respectable, friendly and law-abiding manner.
