

LUB Amendment – Schedule C Sign Regulations

Purpose

 Address the December 4, 2017 motion to amend Schedule C Portable Sign regulations. Specifically, the maximum number of portable signs per property.

Currently:

- Limited to 1 sign per property frontages less than 30m.
- Limited to 2 signs per property greater than 30m frontage.

Previously:

- Limited to two portables in the C2, RC and CC districts only.
- Unlimited portables permitted in C1 and CIS (w/ 30m spacing).





LUB Amendment – Schedule C Sign Regulations

Highlights

- Administration does not recommend that Schedule C portable signs be reverted back to previous wording.
- New amendments ensure fairness and consistency.
- Old provisions provided unfair advantage in C1 & CIS districts. Allowed opportunity for unlimited portables on a site.
- Current Schedule C provides other sign advertising opportunities, in addition to portable signs.





LUB Amendment – Schedule C Sign Regulations

Process

- Existing regulations were approved following consultation of the public, business, industry, and a public hearing process.
- No Portable Sign representative spoke against the proposed Schedule C amendments at that time.
