- great idea. Strongly support both motions. Will assist with combating social isolation especially in the winter.

- concern as to who will carry the burden of making up the lost revenue but understanding that this may be through increased memberships or movement to full use memberships or through tax revenue.

- very valuable to the community

- Concern expressed as to whether or not Servus Place has the capacity to accommodate anticipated growth from this.
