BACKGROUND:

At the regular City of St. Albert Council meeting, February 19th, 2019 the following Motion was debated:

"That a walking track only membership be offered at Servus Place to individuals on a monthly and annual basis."



After further discussion, Council passed the following subsequent motion:

"That the motion be postponed to receive consultation from the Seniors Advisory Committee, the Youth Advisory Committee and the Community Services Advisory Committee"

Administration attended each of the three advisory committee regular monthly meetings, Youth Advisory Committee, March 6th, Seniors Advisory Committee – March 21, and the Community Services Advisory Committee, March 26th, 2019.

The original Administrative Backgrounder, as distributed to Council on February 19th served as the background information – *Attachment 1*. Committee members asked questions to Administration and discussed the motion, exploring various benefits and implications.

Youth Advisory Committee (Meeting March 6th, 2019)

The majority of the Senior Advisory Committee members support offering a pilot of the walking track only membership at Servus Place.
