

Background

- Direction provided for Administration to develop a "Capital Fundraising Campaign Policy".
- Review of current policies, administrative directives, and practices related to funding.





Current Programs

- Community Capital Grant Program
 - Governed by Policy C-CS-06
 - Current maximum of \$250,000
 - Projects normally related to renovations/maintenance/small upgrades
 - Matching program based on Council providing up to 1/3 funding towards the total project budget.





Evolution of Requests for Support

 Initiative has evolved from a desire for a process to address unsolicited requests from external groups for significant funding support for the development of large capital projects.






Additional Process

- New Infrastructure Development Process
 - Current tool used informally to review and analyze significant recreation projects
 - Incorporates principles from:
 - Recreation Master Plan
 - New Facility Predictive Model
 - Partnership Handbook
 - Existing Council Policies
 - Historical Best Practices
