On May 13, 2019, at a meeting of the Governance, Priorities, and Finance Committee, Administration was directed to make amendments to the City's Smoking Bylaw to further prohibit smoking in public parks and on trail within parks, as well as within 10 metres from doorways to public buildings. Administration was also directed to seek the feedback of School Boards, the Community Services Advisory Committee, the Youth Advisory Committee, the Senior Advisory Committee, the Environment Advisory Committee, the Chamber of Commerce, and Homeland Housing with respect to these proposed amendments.

The current <u>Smoking Bylaw</u> prohibits smoking and vaping of all substances in the locations provided:

- at or in any City-owned structural facility;
- within a building;
- on the grounds of an outdoor public event, except in an area reserved for smoking and vaping;
- on a patio;
- inside a public transportation vehicle;
- within 5 metres of a doorway, window, or air intake of a building, an outdoor pool, or a playground; and
- within 5 metres of a seasonal skating rink, skate park, or sports field while it is being used for its intended purpose.

The new Smoking Bylaw, if amended as explained above, would restrict smoking and vaping activity further:

- no smoking and vaping within public parks and on trails within public parks; and
- no smoking and vaping within 10 meters of doorways.

Administration has prepared some maps outlining what the effects of the proposed 10 metre change would look like in comparison to the current 5 metre distance from doorways which currently exists, these are attached for your information. Please provide your comments and feedback with respect to these anticipated changes by July 8, 2019 to Darija Slokar. Your feedback is extremely important to the City and will be presented at a September 2019 City Council meeting when the amendments to the Smoking Bylaw are brought for Council's consideration. Council will debate the item at that time, and your feedback will be taken into consideration.
