AMENDING BYLAW 26/2019 Being Amendment 3 to Smoking Bylaw 1/2004

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of St. Albert, duly assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Bylaw 1/2004, being the Smoking Bylaw, is hereby amended as follows:

- a. The word “marijuana” is deleted and replaced with the word “cannabis” in subsection 2(f);
- b. A new subsection 2(k.) is added:

2(k.1) “Park” means any developed or undeveloped space owned, controlled, or maintained by the City that is:

- (i) dedicated for the common use and enjoyment of the public;*
- (ii) intended to be used by members of the public for recreation and general enjoyment;*
- (iii) preserved as a natural area;*
- (iv) designated or districted as park or park corridor land; or*
- (v) dedicated as municipal reserve, environmental reserve, or a public utility pursuant to the Municipal Government Act RSA 2000 c.M-26 (and all amendments and succeeding legislation).*

For the purposes of this Bylaw, Parks include walkways and pathways contained within the Parks, named Parks, open green spaces, green spaces surrounding storm-water ponds and systems, Playgrounds, Sports Fields, Skate Parks, and Seasonal Skating Rinks;

- c. The word “Procedures” is deleted and replaced with the word “Procedure” in subsection 2(m);
- d. Subsection 2(v) is removed and replaced with the following:
2(u) “Smoke” or “Smoking” means

- (i) *inhaling or exhaling the smoke produced by lit, burning, ignited, or heated tobacco or any other substance;*
- (vii) *holding or otherwise having control of lit, burning, ignited, or heated tobacco or cannabis;*
- (viii) *inhaling or exhaling the vapour, emissions, or aerosol produced by an Electronic Smoking Device or similar device containing any substance; or*
- (ix) *holding or otherwise having control of an Electronic Smoking Device or similar device that is producing vapour, emissions, or aerosol from any substance;*

e. A new subsection 2(v.1) is added:

2(v.1) “Traditional Pipe Ceremonies” means any cultural or religious ceremony involving pipes or the use or consumption of tobacco products; and

f. The word “Procedures” is deleted and replaced with the word “Procedure” in subsection 2(w);

g. A new subsection 3(1)(d.1) is added:

3(1)(d.1) within a Park; and

h. The word “doorway” is deleted from subsection 3(2)(a);

i. A new subsection 3(2.1) is added:

(2.1) Unless an exception applies under this Bylaw, no person may Smoke within 10 metres of a doorway of a Building.

j. Subsection 3(4) is deleted and replaced with the following:

3(4) Subsections (1), (2)(a) and (2.1) do not apply to Private Living Accommodations.

k. A new section 4.1 is added:

4.1 Traditional Pipe Ceremonies are exempt from this Bylaw.; and

l. The remaining sections and subsections are renumbered accordingly.

2. The Chief Administrative Officer is authorized to consolidate Bylaw 1/2004.
