The CSAC has recommended funding for the 2020 Community Capital Program Grant applicants as follows:

Application #1 – Dynamyx Gymnastics Club of St. Albert

- Project: Renovations / Improvements at the new Dynamyx Facility
- Funding Request: \$250,000
- CSAC Recommended Funding: \$94,815
- Dynamyx is requesting funding to offset costs from the Tenant Improvements at their new location. The project allows for expansion of available space to conduct gymnastics and other activities in a more built-to-suit environment. The design layout allows for multipurpose use of the space as user groups can safely run programs simultaneously with competitive and recreational gymnastics training. Total project budget is \$978,474 and the recommendation for funding is \$94,815.

Application #2 – Keenooshayo Parents' Association

- Project: Playground Replacement
- Funding Request: \$65,000
- CSAC Recommended Funding: \$65,000
- The school parent association is requesting funds to assist with the redevelopment of the existing play structure located on the school grounds. The structure has been rated as in poor condition by a 2018 City of St. Albert assessment. The redevelopment will increase the playground in size and will provide for a greater range of activities to support the needs of the school and the broader community. Total project budget is \$197,000 and the recommendation from CSAC is for funding in the amount of \$65,000.

Application #3 – Sir Alexander McKenzie Fundraising Society

- Project: Additional play equipment & benches
- Funding Request: \$19,000
- CSAC Recommended Funding: \$19,000
- The school parent association is requesting funds to add a section of monkey bars and a piece of spinning equipment to cover off all the core play locomotives for children. They are also replacing sand with wood chips and adding bench seating to make the playground more welcoming. Total project budget is \$57,013 and the recommendation for funding is \$19,000.

Application #4 – St. Albert & District Further Education Association

- Project: Renovations
- Funding Request: \$2,873
- CSAC Recommended Funding: \$2,873
- The interior renovations include replacement of lighting and light boxes, updating the kitchen, painting, and small surface improvements. The organization anticipates an annual cost saving of \$1200 by replacing the lighting boxes and older type bulbs. Total project budget is \$8,619 and the recommendation for funding is \$2,873.

Application #5 – St. Albert Men's Slowpitch Association

- Project: Storage compound and lighting refurbishing project
- Funding Request: \$31,888

- CSAC Recommended Funding: \$31,888
- The project involves building a two-compartment storage compound, one for garbage and one for shale reserve. The lighting portion of this project includes relamping fixtures on four diamonds. This Total project budget is \$95,663 and the recommendation for funding is \$31,888.

Application #6 - St. Albert Nordic Ski Club

- Project: Purchase of a Narrow Ginzu Groomer
- Funding Request: \$3,773
- CSAC Recommended Funding: \$3,773
- The club is seeking funding support to offset the cost of purchasing a narrow ginzu groomer. The new groomer will allow the group to set a single track for cross country skiing and renovate when conditions become icy. The groomer will improve safety for the volunteers operating. Use of the groomed trails by residents is free of charge. Total project budget is \$11,320 and the recommendation for funding is \$3,773.

Application #7 – St. Albert Tennis Club

- Project: Bench Replacement
- Funding Request: \$2,096
- CSAC Recommended Funding: \$2,096
- The club is seeking funding support for the replacement of the existing run-down benches for a product which is more durable, lower maintenance, and provides increased comfort for the members. Total project budget is \$8,383 and the recommendation for funding is \$2,096.

Application #8 – Star of the North Retreat House

- Project: Facility refresh & safety improvements (exterior & interior)
- Funding Request: \$30,555
- CSAC Recommended Funding: \$30,555
- This project includes painting of the building exterior, refurbishing and painting the fire escapes for greater safety and security, front door replacement to provide handicap accessibility, and capping the windows. Total project budget is \$91,665 and the recommendation for funding is \$30,555.
