amended as follows:

That the Community Living Standing Committee



recommend to Council that if the Municipal Historic Conservation Program reserve has a balance of \$100,000 or greater as of June 30 of that calendar year, the annual funding contribution available for the program is allocated at \$0 per capita.

That if the reserve amount has a balance of less than \$100,000 as of June 30 of that calendar year, the amount of annual funding available for the program is determined by multiplying the city's population, as determined by the most recent census, by \$0.50.

That if the Municipal Historic Conservation Program reserve amount has a balance of less than \$60,000 as of June 30 of that calendar year, the Municipal Historic Conservation Program policy and annual funding contribution is brought before council for review.
