## **BACKGROUND:**

It is Administration's understanding of the proposed motion that the City Manager will send a letter to St. Albert Public Schools, Greater St. Albert Catholic Schools, and Conseil Scolaire Centre-Nord to determine their long-term interests in the Oakmont and Kingswood school sites.
