That Section 17.1 of Procedure Bylaw 22/2016 be suspended for the 2018 Budget Process to allow the mover of a motion to move an amendment to the same motion.

That consideration of proposed amendments to the Draft 2018 Municipal and Utility Capital Budgets and the 2018 Municipal Operating Budget made during presentations be automatically postponed until all presentations have been completed.

That Committee of the Whole be authorized to direct Administration, by resolution, to make changes to the Draft

That the number of new FTEs is reduced from 14 to 7, and Administration determine and advise Council which 7 FTEs are selected.

That the Tree Canopy Expansion Co-op Program for \$75,000 is postponed to 2020.

#### Postponed Motion - Councillor Hughes

That the engineering consulting support business case for \$60,000 is moved from the base budget to the growth budget and the tax base adjusted accordingly.

#### Postponed Motion - Councillor Hughes

Community Survey - Environmental Issues and Priorities is fully funded from municipal assessment growth for \$35,000, and the utility operating budget is reduced by \$17,500, and the utility rates are adjusted accordingly.

#### Postponed Motion - Councillor Hughes

That the bulk water dispensing unit for \$50,000 is funded from the capital budget and the utility rates are adjusted accordingly.

#### Postponed Motion - Councillor Hughes

That the curbside waste composition study for \$50,000 is unfunded and the utility rates are adjusted accordingly.
