**PURPOSE OF REPORT**

On May 23, 2018 Councillor Hansen provided notice in accordance with Section 23 of Procedure Bylaw 3/2018 that she intended to bring forward the proposed motion below.

**PROPOSED MOTION(S):**

That a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) be prepared with Active Communities by xxxx (date) that will serve to support the concept of a Sport and Wellness Campus.
