#### RECOMMENDED MOTION

#### PURPOSE OF REPORT

Due to a recent resignation, this report is brought forward to fill one vacancy on the Environmental Advisory Committee.

#### ALIGNMENT TO COUNCIL DIRECTION OR MANDATORY STATUTORY PROVISION

Section 10(1) and 10(2) of the Environmental Advisory Committee Bylaw 35/2015 provides that:

Notwithstanding the foregoing sections, if, for any reason, a Member vacates his or her membership on the Committee part of the way through that Member's Term, Council shall appoint as a replacement Member

- (a) a resident of St. Albert; or
- (b) a Councillor, if the vacating Member is a Councillor.

The replacement Member referred to in subsection (1) shall serve the remainder of the vacating Member's Term.

#### **BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION**

In February of 2021, Ms. A. Lefebvre submitted her resignation as a member of the Environmental Advisory Committee. This member had been appointed to the Committee effective January 1, 2020 for term ending December 31, 2021 and as a result of her resignation, an appointment of one new member to fill the remainder of the term of the vacating member, is brought forward for Council's consideration.
