REASON FOR TIME EXTENSION REQUEST

On December 2, 2019, Council passed Motion CB-19-022. Recommendation 4 read as follows:

"That the formal Indigenous Advisory Committee is brought forward for further discussion at an overall committee review discussion in Q1 2020".

At Council's January 2020 strategic planning retreat an initial dialogue was held in-camera regarding the establishment of a formal Indigenous Advisory Committee. Community Relations requests a time extension until Q4 2021 so that we may present the new Council with a recommendation for how the municipality can proceed on collaborating with, and receiving guidance from, the Indigenous Community.
